

Cliff Notes/HogsBack Heritage Project Workshop Information Sheet

Location

Boulder, Utah is located 250 miles south of Salt Lake City (4 1/2 hours) or 150 miles (3 hours) east of Cedar City. It is the heart of the Grand Staircase National Monument on Scenic By-way - Highway 12. It is 88 miles (2 hours) west of Bryce Canyon National Park and is just over the mountain from Capitol Reef National Park. It is a very remote community with a population of 180 residents. Travel from Salt Lake is faster if you go towards Fish Lake and Capitol Reef from I-80 10 miles east of Richfield and go over Boulder Mountain to Boulder. Google will take you through Panguitch which will take longer.
